

SPECIAL OLYMPICS MEDICALS

Medical forms must be signed by a doctor.

Medicals are valid for 3 years.

After 3 years, a new medical must be submitted. However, if the student does not have any of the first 6 health conditions listed on the Health History section, a doctor's signature is not required. "

The parent or guardian must sign the medical.
The social security and date of birth must be written on the medical.

It is your responsibility to make sure that medicals are on file at the State **Special** Olympics office **PRIOR TO COMPETITION**. Phone: 1-800-239-3898. You can fax a list (of your students' names to 334-262-9794 and Marilyn will check them for you. Faxed copies of medicals will not be accepted.

The release form is valid as long as the athlete competes,
YOU DO NOT NEED TO HAVE A NEW RELEASE FORM SIGNED IF ONE IS ON FILE AT THE STATE SPECIAL OLYMPICS OFFICE.
