As we plan for our reopening for hybrid instruction on Monday, October 5, 2020, we will adhere to the following protocols:

Students who selected a traditional instructional format will be the only students permitted on campus.

Students who selected a traditional instructional format will adhere to the following A/B Schedule:

A/B Schedule

Monday/Tuesday - October 5th, 6th, 12th and 13th:

Students with last names beginning with A-L

Wednesday – October 7, 14

All students remote, schools will be cleaned

Thursday/Friday - October 8th, 9th, 15th and 16th:

Students with last names beginning with M-Z

Students will report to their first block class and remain in first block for the entire day on Monday, October 5.

Students will report to their second block class and remain in second block for the entire day on Tuesday, October 6.

Each subsequent day, students will report to the following block. For example, students will report to their third block class and remain in third block for the entire day on Thursday, October 8.

Students will be coded as remote learners if the parent did not select an instructional choice. Remote is our instructional default choice.

Students who report to school on unscheduled days will face disciplinary action.

Students will have their temperatures checked as they enter school.

Buses will run their regular routes. Students who are enrolled in traditional instruction will be the only students who are allowed to load the busses.

Students who are car riders or are walkers will be granted admission to Center Point High School beginning at 7:15 A.M.

Students must bring a fully-charged electronic device, a charger, and a pair of headphones each day they are assigned to attend school.

Students are permitted to bring a bottle of water to school. The use of the school water fountain is prohibited.

Students will eat breakfast and lunch in their classrooms. We will maintain social distancing to ensure we do not have large gatherings of students.

Students must respect and adhere to the COVID-19 signage displayed throughout the building.

All students and staff are required to wear a face mask or a face covering at all times.

Students are encouraged to frequently sanitize their hands.

Anyone experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 is prohibited from entering the campus of Center Point High School.
