Clay-Chalkville Middle School students will begin taking the Alabama Comprehensive Assessment Program (ACAP) as our State test this year. This test will be of great value to understanding the current and future academic needs of your child.

Due to testing security policies the ACAP tests can only be administered at Clay-Chalkville Middle School. Students are required to come to Clay-Chalkville Middle School to test; there will be no off-site or remote testing allowed.

The staff at Clay-Chalkville Middle School are preparing the safest environment possible and adhering to guidelines set by the Alabama State Department of Education and American College Test standards of practice.
