

Hello, parents. My name is Amanda McLaughlin, and I am the sixth grade assistant principal at Clay-Chalkville Middle School. I am so excited to meet all of your students in a couple of weeks. I would like to invite all sixth grade students to attend Cougar Camp on Monday, August 8th from 8:30 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. We will take this opportunity to introduce your students to our school, give them guided tours, and allow them to walk through their schedules. We hope this will ease any anxiety on their part and prepare them for their first day of middle school on the following day.

To familiarize parents with the drop off and pick up procedures at CCMS, parents will use the car line in the back of the school to drop off students on Monday morning between 8:15 and 8:30. Parents will then use the car line at the front of the school to pick up students at 11:00 a.m. Signs will be posted to help guide you to the correct drop off and pick up locations. Neither breakfast nor lunch will be served.

I would like to remind you all that Snapcodes for PowerSchool enrollment were emailed to the email address on file with JEFCEOD. Look for an email from PowerSchool. Please follow those instructions for completing registration. Also, for the 2022-2023 school year, parents will need to apply for free and reduced meals! For the past two years, JEFCEOD has been able to supply all students with free breakfast and lunch because of federal funding. However, the federal waiver has expired and school districts across the country are once again taking applications for free and reduced meals. Students qualify for the program based on their household income level. If you are unsure of your family's eligibility, we encourage you to apply! If you are unable to apply online, please contact the school for a paper application.

If you need help in completing registration online, you may schedule an appointment by calling the school and speaking with Ms. Tinsley, the registrar. Appointments will be taken from 8-11 a.m. only, Monday through Thursday. No walk-ins will be accepted.

The first day of school is Tuesday, August 9th.
