Hueytown Middle School parents,

This letter is a weekly reminder that your student may have been exposed to a COVID-19 positive individual while in a classroom, extracurricular group, or on a school bus.

Your student is not excluded from school or school activities.

Please monitor your student daily for the following symptoms:

- **Fever, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion/runny nose, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea**

If **any one** of these symptoms are observed, isolate immediately, seek medical care and contact your school nurse.

COVID-19 positive students must follow these procedures:

- Must be isolated for at least **5 days** after symptoms first appear or **5 days** from the test date for asymptomatic individuals
- Must be fever-free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications at the end of the 5 day period
- Improvement of all other symptoms
- Upon returning to school, the student must wear a mask for at least 5 days.

If the above criteria are not met, the student should isolate for a total of 10 days.

Students who have not tested positive for COVID-19 or are not symptomatic should attend school.
