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Dear Parent or Guardian,

Hueytown Middle School will begin administering the ACAP Summative Assessment and ACAP Alternate Assessment to our students beginning the week of March 15. Grade level testing will continue throughout the month of April, with all testing being completed by April 30. Our students will take English Language Arts and Mathematics assessments. Additionally, students in grades 6 and 8 will take a Science assessment.

During the administration of these assessments, the safety of our students and staff is our highest priority. Hueytown Middle School will continue to adhere to guidelines established by the Centers for Disease Control, which include daily cleaning of classrooms and instructional materials. We will also adhere to social distancing guidelines, and maintain appropriate spacing between students during the administration of these assessments.

For the following reasons, Hueytown Middle School will utilize remote learning days to ensure that all students can be tested before the testing window closes on April 30th:

- Social distancing guidelines limit the number of students that can be tested at one time.
- Additional staff will be needed to ensure that all students can be tested.
- Additional classrooms must be available to ensure that all students are adequately and safely spaced.
- Designated days are needed to bring remote students in for testing.

The remote students will be the only students on campus from March 17th-March 19th and April 13th & 14th (Make-Up Days). All traditional students will have E-Learning days on the aforementioned days.

The testing schedule for Hueytown Middle School Remote students is as follows:

March 18th	Math	Grades 6-8	8:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m.
March 19th	Science	Grades 6th & 8th Only	8:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m.
April 13th	Make-Up Testing	Grades 6-8	8:00a.m.-3:00p.m.
April 14	Make-Up Testing	Grades 6-8	8:00a.m.-3:00p.m.

Students will have the opportunity to eat breakfast and lunch on testing days. Traditional students will begin receiving breakfast and lunch to take home on March 9th in preparation for upcoming remote days. Students will also have transportation available if they qualify for a school bus. Parents of remote learners, if you have questions about transportation, please contact Mr. Ford, jford@jefcoed.com by March 12th. All students will need to bring their Chromebook and charger with them on testing days.
