

TYPICAL PEER Preschool Opportunity

The application process for our Typical Peer Preschool Program for the 2022-2023 school year has opened and we are continuing to take applications. This program offers an opportunity for typically developing three and four year olds to participate in a pre-Kindergarten program as role models. Preschool units are located at Burkett Center, Center Point Elementary, Hueytown Primary, McAdory Elementary, Pinson Elementary, and U.W. Clemon Elementary School. You must have your child's name on the list in order for your child to be assigned a screening date and time. Call Donna Powers at our Pre-school office at 205-379-2820, to have your child's name added to the list of students to be screened. The cost for participation in the Typical Peer Preschool Program is \$225.00 per month with full payment due on the 1st of each month. Students will be released from the program if tuition is not paid on time or other standards are not met.

To be eligible for the program a student must:

- Be fully toilet trained (no pull-ups)
- Demonstrate developmentally appropriate language, behavior, adaptive, and social skills
- Separate easily from family
- Live in the Jefferson County School Zone

(Jefferson County Board of Education employee's children are not required to live in Jefferson County.)

-Have no IEP

Parents must follow all set rules and guidelines for students to remain in the program.

Students are selected for the program based on development. We are looking for caring students with good behavior who will be a great role model for others. Students chosen for the program are notified by phone. This sign up is for the 2022-2023 school year. For more information, contact Pre-school at 205-379-2820. Transportation is not provided.
