2016-2017 Kindergarten DIBELS Next Results

- 77% were at or above benchmark in Phonemic Segmentation Fluency (PSF).
- 60% were at or above benchmark in Nonsense Word Fluency (NWF).



2016-2017 1st & 2nd Global Scholar Results

- 1st grade Reading Foundations - 52% scored high or above average. Increased 331 points in yearly gains.
- 1st grade Math - 30% scored high or above average. Increased 178 points in yearly gains.
- 2nd grade Reading Foundations - 63% scored high or above average. Increased 218 points in yearly gains.
- 2nd grade Math - 40% scored high or above average. Increased 147 points in yearly gains.

A Continuous Improvement Plan (CIP) is developed each year in order to improve instructional programs which directly impact the achievement of all students. The leadership team reviewed and analyzed our school data and determined the following areas of focus.

Academics

Goal: Preparing all students to be college and career ready upon graduation.

Objective: Demonstrate student proficiency (pass rate) in reading and math by 05/25/2018 as measured by increased student performance on state and local assessments.

- ★ This will be done through teacher professional development (PD), teacher collaboration and implementation of strategies learned in PD, increased rigor of core curriculum, and small group instruction for EL and struggling students.

Parenting

Parent surveys have been analyzed by the continuous improvement leadership team. Parenting activities will be developed and resources will be purchased based on those results. Parenting activities will include, but not limited to: Annual Title I Meeting, Take-a-Peek, Family Literacy Night, SMART Night, Parent/Teacher Conferences, etc.
