MORTIMER JORDAN HIGH SCHOOL PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

The Mortimer Jordan athlete must:

- 1. Meet all eligibility requirements set by the AHSAA and the Jefferson County Board of Education.
- Attend all practices and games unless properly excused by your coach. One absence without an acceptable excuse will bring extra work; a second absence will result in the athlete being excused from the team.
- 3. NOT use or be in possession of alcohol or other drugs (without a doctor's excuse)
 - Violation of this agreement will result in a suspension period and bring extra work. This will be determined by the principal, coach, and athletic director on an individual basis.
 - A second violation will result in immediate dismissal from the Mortimer Jordan Athletic Program and all athletic teams for ONE CALENDAR YEAR.
- 4. Not use or be in possession of tobacco products. Violation of this rule will bring extra work and possibly a suspension period. A second offense will result in a suspension period and extra work.
- 5. Not be suspended from school. Suspension will result in the athlete not being eligible for practices or games during the suspension period.
- 6. Participate in our off season programs, including summer workouts.
- 7. Be responsible for all equipment and uniforms issued to him/her. He/she must pay for any lost or damaged items.
- 8. Assist in the maintenance of the athletic facilities and dressing areas.
- 9. Complete one sport's season (all practices and contests) before beginning another sport's season or practices and contests. (An athlete will not be permitted to quit one sport in order to participate in another sport. The athlete who quits will only be allowed to begin participation in practices and contests of the new sport after the conclusion of the season of the sport quit).

MALE ATHLETES:

- 1. Must not wear hair touching the collar, should be out of the eyes, and sideburns clearly above the ear lobes.
- 2. Must abide by dress code.
- 3. Tattoos are strongly discouraged.
- 4. May have facial hair, but it must be neat and well groomed.

FEMALE ATHLETES:

- 1. Must not wear any jewelry during practice or competitions.
- 2. Must wear hair according to coach's specification.
- 3. Must abide by dress code.

CURFEW DURING SEASON

- At home by 10:00 P.M. on weekdays and Sundays.
